

The 4-H Annual Deep Pit BBQ is Humboldt County 4-H's largest and most important fundraiser, playing a huge role in funding the general operation of 4-H in the county, as well as the main source of scholarship funds.

100% of the meat served at the Annual Deep Pit barbecue is raised locally and donated at either the Humboldt County Fair Livestock Auction or Redwood Acres Fair.

4-H Enrollment is open year-round. But the best time of year to enroll is now, before project meetings have begun. Have questions about 4-H? Here are some answers to frequently asked questions.

How old does my child have to be to join 4-H?

Youth are eligible to participate in 4-H as primary members if they are 5 years old or in kindergarten as of December 31st of the program year (July-June).
